

Huron Band Parents, Inc. Annual Scholarship

Band Parent's Organization Scholarship

The Band Parent's Organization will award a scholarship or multiple scholarships to a graduating student(s) who will continue their education at the college level. All senior band and drill team members are eligible. The scholarship(s) will be awarded at the annual band banquet in the spring.

One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded annually, and then others that will range from \$100 to \$500 per student based on the number of applicants, and as the Huron Band Parents Executive board deems necessary and possible. Each year, the overall amount for scholarships shall be included in the band parents budget, however the exact amount will be at the discretion of the executive board and will be given a final determination in March of the year. The budgeted amount will be merely a goal, final determination will depend upon the financial status of the Huron Band Parents, Inc. in March of the year. The Huron Band parents reserves the right to give less than the budgeted goal depending on financial status of the organization.

The Band Parent's Board, with input from the Band Director, Assistant Director and Tigerette Director will award the scholarship. In the event a board member has an eligible student, the board member will refrain from participating in the selection process.

Each qualifying and interested student must submit an application requesting consideration for the scholarship. The application must be submitted to the Band Parent's Organization President by March 1st of the applicable year. Return applications to the following:

- Demonstrated skills as a musician.
- Demonstrated leadership qualities in the band program.
- Academic achievements.
- Future goals and college plans.
- Participation in Huron Band Parent fundraising activities.

Criteria for scholarship eligibility explained:

1. Additional consideration will be given to somebody seeking to further their education at the college level in music, however this criteria will not be the sole deciding factor in awarding scholarships.
2. Scholarship applicants will have had involvement in HHS Band Activities, extra curricular band activities, and community service hours on behalf of the band in the form of fundraising efforts.
3. Band Directors will have input to the scholarship award decision. Band directors input will be based upon the students school performance, leadership characteristics, talent and efforts, and competition in solo and ensemble among other criteria deemed important by the band directors.
4. Scholarship applicant must be a member in good standing of the Huron Band Program, and shall not be under suspension from school, or from band activities at the time prior to or of the award. Additional consideration will be given to those students that have been in high school band all four years, however this will not be a sole deciding factor.
5. Student and parental participation in the Huron Band Parents, Inc. organization events, work details, and fundraising efforts will be given additional consideration, however this will not be a sole deciding factor.
6. Scholarship applications will be legible. Those including additional information such as high school transcript, college goals, and any other information that the applicant deems important and that should be considered by the awards committee should be included in the application.

The Board Members of the Huron Band Parent Association will review each and every application received by March 1st. Applications received after March 1st. will not be considered.
